Dear Parents & Students,

Hello! We hope you had a great summer and are ready for an exciting school year! This school year we will be moving to a more structured dress code. This new dress code will allow students to wear specific solid colors and EHS will be providing TWO shirts for each new student, free of charge. Additionally, during the school year we will have specific days that students will be allowed to wear clothing of their choice. i.e. Seahawk days/Game day, etc.

Acceptable colors and dress code for K-12 includes:

- Solid colored shirts: GOLD, LIGHT GREEN, or DARK BLUE.
- Shirts can be collared or uncollared.
- No logos.
- Pullovers in the appropriate color with only school related logos.
- Skirts, shorts, dresses must be at knee length.

Unacceptable dress code includes:

- Torn or ripped clothing.
- Exposing undergarments.
- Hats.
- Clothing or accessories that implies gang membership.
- Clothing or accessories with endorsements of any illegal activity, advertisements for tobacco, alcohol, or drugs.
- Clothing or accessories with derogatory, obscene, violent or suggestive statements and connotations.
- Sweatpants.
- Trench coats or excessively bulky clothing.
